

# Cookie policy

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises that cookie. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognise a user's device. Websites use techniques that increase user-friendliness and make the site as interesting as possible for each visitor. The best known examples of such techniques are cookies and other ways to store information on your device. (hereafter "cookies"). Cookies may be used by website owners or by third parties - advertisers, for example - who communicate via the website you visit.

We think it is very important that you know which cookies our website uses and for which purposes they are used. We want to guarantee your privacy and user-friendliness as much as possible. Below you can read more about the cookies that are used by and through our website and for which purposes.

## For what do we use cookies?

We use cookies for the following reasons:

- To make sure the website functions properly
- To measure usage of the website - analytic cookies
- To allow you to login on our website via social media

## Functional cookies

Below we make clear how we use cookies for these applications.

- To make sure the website functions properly
- Our website uses cookies and local storage for:
  - remembering your settings like, that you are logged in, preferred currency, consent status and if you used the referral system
- securing your session;

### **Analytics cookies**

In order to determine which parts of the website are most interesting for our visitors, we continuously try to measure, with the help of third party software, the number of visitors to our website and the most frequently viewed parts. We use cookies and local storage for this purpose.

The information we collect in this way is used to compile statistics. These statistics give us insight into how often our platform page is visited, where exactly visitors spend most of their time, and so on. This enables us to make the structure, navigation and content of the website as user-friendly as possible for you.

We use cookies for:

- Measure which pages you visit, which elements you clicked on and what the details of your booking are.
- Measure the effect of our marketing campaigns.
- Measure how long you visited our platform.
- Get cross-device insights.

### **To allow you to login on our website via social media**

When using Facebook login functionality cookies are set to identify your account.

- These cookies are used to:
- Use your Facebook account for logging in on our platform.

For the cookies that social media parties place and the possible data that they collect, we refer to the statements that these parties provide on their own websites about this; see the links below. Please note that these statements are subject to change on a regular basis. We have no influence over that. On a regular basis we check whether the information third parties submit is up to date.

Please note that you will need to change the settings separately for each browser and computer you use.
